Some of Our Girl Talk Marlton Activities

- **Weekly mentoring sessions**—regular peer-led group meetings addressing self-esteem, social media pressure, friendship, mental health, and leadership.
- **Leader mentor programs**—girls in 9th grade and above lead sessions and support younger members
- **Arts & crafts, game nights, and social mixers**—creative activities to foster friendship and personal confidence.
- **Service Projects** -such as Blessing Bags, monthly PB & J sandwich making events, clothing and food collections for local families in need
- **Lemonade stand fundraiser**—raising awareness and funds for childhood cancer support group Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation
- **Community Interaction**- attend activities in town (such as, National Night Out) to promote kindness and connection to spread our message.
- **Monthly speakers** -based on our theme
- Partnership with the awesome **Evesham Township Police Department** who visit us weekly.
- And so much more:....bowling, movies, mini golf, dinners, Friendsgiving, jewelry designs, candle making, fairy gardens, pool parties, ice cream socials, trivia nights, sticker shock project, dance parties, clothing swaps, holiday parties, bocce, self defense class, board games, music time, rock painting, field day, birthday parties, graduation celebrations, costume parties, smores making, and whatever else our leaders want to do this year.



Girl Talk Marlton is a free, local mentoring group for girls ages 10 to 18. High school girls' mentor younger girls in a safe, fun, and supportive space. They meet regularly to talk about real-life issues like self-esteem, friendship, social media, and stress—while also doing fun activities like crafts, events, and community service.

It's all about helping girls feel confident, heard, and connected. The group encourages kindness, leadership, and making new friends—without judgment. It's been making a difference in the Marlton community since 2013.

Girl Talk Marlton offers a fun, supportive space where girls ages connect, grow, and lead. Weekly mentoring sessions cover real-life topics like self-esteem, friendship struggles, social media pressure, and mental health, all led by teen mentors and junior leaders. The group also hosts creative events like crafts, games, and social mixers to help girls build confidence and friendships. Members get the chance to take on leadership roles, guide younger girls, and learn how to use their voice in meaningful ways. Girl Talk also gives back through community service projects and events. We teach the importance of kindness and connection. It's free to join, open to all, and built to help girls feel heard, empowered, and supported.
